

Jim Miller receives 2006 IEEE Achievement Award



Jim Miller has been named as the recipient of the IEEE Ultrasonics, Ferroelectrics, and Frequency Control Society's 2006 Achievement Award.

The Achievement Award is the highest Society-wide award presented to a member in special recognition of outstanding contributions. Selection criteria include significant technical publications in the field of ultrasonics, ferroelectrics, or frequency control, as well as contributions to these technical fields, and service to the Society. Winner is selected by the Officers and the Awards Committee from nominations submitted by the general membership.

The presentation will be made at the Society's Ultrasonics Symposium to be held in Vancouver in early October.

The award consists of an honorarium of \$2,000, a plaque and a certificate.
